Proposal Discussion for Fed KMWG on Inter-Agency Collaboration

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July 23, 2009

Purpose

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- Develop a proposal for the Federal CIO for how the Federal KMWG can support the goals of the administration by
 - Creating an inventory of practices in knowledge management, sharing, and collaboration within and between agencies
 - Promoting the best practices in intra- and inter-agency collaboration
 - ***Additional activities that show the value the KMWG brings to the CIO discussions—what are the ways you see KMWG providing better insight or decision support for the Federal government (e.g., KM Initiative, tacit knowledge capture)?***

Suggested Outcomes

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- Inventory of KM systems, processes, and capabilities in use by federal, state, local, and tribal governments
 - Comprehensive view
 - Organize KM services by capability, reusability, success metrics ...
 - Best practice from organizational perspective
- Recommendations/best practices
 - Should we suggest best practices amongst organizations?
 - How could we bring in industry best practices?
 - How do we handle recommendations from commercial providers?

Suggested Project Plan

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- Proposal on approach, benefits, and outcomes to Federal CIO by July 30
- Inventory initial view: August 21
 - Three submissions from each federal agency and representation from at least one state, one local, and one tribal government
 - Ongoing updates: no end date, will evolve
- Recommendations: September 30
 - One best practice from each federal agency and representation from at least one state, one local, and one tribal government

- How do we collect lessons learned about KM rather than just a practice?
